

CONFERENCE FORMAT

Initially, the conference was to be held physically in Mumbai, later due to COVID it was planned to have it as hybrid event but gradually we had to do it as an online even for all in Mumbai where a set of partners, invitees, etc. join the conference, deliver lectures, engage with each other.

The three-day conference comprised of 6 sessions, with 6 speakers per session. Each speaker was given 10-15 minutes to present, followed by 10 minutes for questions. The participants were encouraged to ask questions around the theme of the conference and the speakers' presentations.

CONFERENCE THEMES


The events during the three days were based on themes related to the Professional Development Programs and case studies taken by BReUCom.

- Compilation of all institutional PDPs and e learning from SPARC and CURE as packaged courses which can be put together on a platform and can have a longer shelf-life.


